Andrew Thomas gave a brief overview of the meeting's agenda and went through the materials included in the Board Meeting packet. Brad Erickson made the motion, seconded by Denise Garcia, to approve the Consent Calendar. All in favor.

A. WVIA Vice-Chair Election

The WVIA Board will elect a Vice-Chair

Jessice Dabney made the motion, seconded by Bill Tucker, to elect Brad Erickson as Vice-Chair of the WVIA Board of Directors. All in favor.

B. Ad Hoc Nominating Committee

The WVIA Board Chair will appoint an Ad Hoc Nominating Committee to interview candidates, and then nominate candidates to serve on the WVIA Board of Directors in a Zone 1 and Zone 2 seat.

Jim made the motion, seconded by Denise Garcia, to appoint the Executive Committee members (Jim Brooks, Brad Erickson, Kifishia Kawachi, Kevin Crummy, and Jessica Dabney) to serve on the Ad Hoc Nominating Committee. All in favor.

C. WVIA Bylaws

The WVIA Board will hear a recommendation from the Executive Committee to amend Section 4.07 of the WVIA Bylaws. Section 4.07 states, "... Regular meetings of the Board following the Annual Board Meeting shall be held monthly with a minimum of nine (9) meetings or more frequently as determined by the Board, at such time and place within the boundaries of the Westwood Business Improvement District,, as shall from time to time be determined by the Board..." The recommended amendment states, "...Regular meetings of the Board, including the Annual Board Meeting, shall be held a minimum of four (4) times per year or more frequently as determined by the Board, at such time and place, within the boundaries of the Westwood Business Improvement District as shall from time to time be determined by the Board..." The Board should calendar six meetings in 2019.

Brad Erickson made the motion, seconded by Dean Abell, to amend the Bylaws to read... "...Regular meetings of the Board, including the Annual Board Meeting, shall be held a minimum of six (6) times per year or more frequently as determined by the Board, at such time and place, within the boundaries of the Westwood Business Improvement District as shall from time to time be determined by the Board... "In favor: Brad Erickson, Dean Abell, Jim Brooks, Peter Clinco, Kevin Crummy, Denise Garcia, John Heidt, Kifishia Kawachi, Bill Tucker. Opposed: Jessica Dabney. Motion passed.

- Secure, and activate, a Glendon and a Gayley Parklet
- Evaluate current movie premier activity

Clean, Safe, and Beautiful

- Repair, and add where possible, District electrical infrastructure
- Repair/Paint District Infrastructure (trash cans, benches, light poles, bollards, etc)
- Continue to find ways to affect homelessness in the district (advocate for City ordinances, State legislation, work with the local businesses and the Ad Hoc Affecting Homelessness Committee)
- Complete sidewalk reconstruction
- Improve District landscaping

Executive Committee

- Conduct the 2018 Audit
- Determine 2020 assessments
- Determine the 2020 Budget and Annual Planning Report
- WVSP "Report Back" from Planning response
- Devise Westwood economic assessment and tenanting strategies
- Evaluate WBID C-4 Zoning

- Improve operations/management/leasing of the Broxton Parking Structure
- Advocate for Metro "Last Mile" recommendations and continued monitoring of Metro Purple Line Extension project
- Advocate for improved mobility in the District
- Implement the \$5 After 5PM pilot program
- Establish the Parking Benefit District
- Evaluate District valet program
